Some families may remember that in 2019 we launched a fundraising scheme called Keep it EP. Reduced funding for schools and rising costs have direct implications on our enrichment offer, as spending is targeted at core teaching and learning. Keep it EP was launched to fundraise in support of all the extras that make EP special - for the many trips and workshops, projects and classes with dance, science, sport and music specialists, for wellbeing support and for the enhancement of the school site.

Academic attainment is fundamental, and by supporting the curriculum with our enrichment offer, we can provide greater rigour, depth and breadth, and give greater context and meaning to learning. We know too that children flourish where there is the opportunity to try new experiences, learn from experts and to do so in stimulating, interesting environments. At a time of reduced funding and increased cost affecting all our lives, we believe that these visits, arts experiences and sporting opportunities are crucial!

Our vision for the school requires renewed emphasis on enrichment. We have so much more that we would like to offer our children, and to develop in terms of music, arts and wellbeing.
