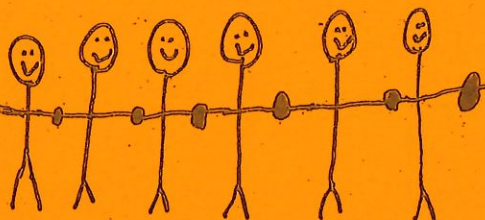

This is a **2km fun run fundraiser for EP with the goal of raising £10k towards our wellness programme**. 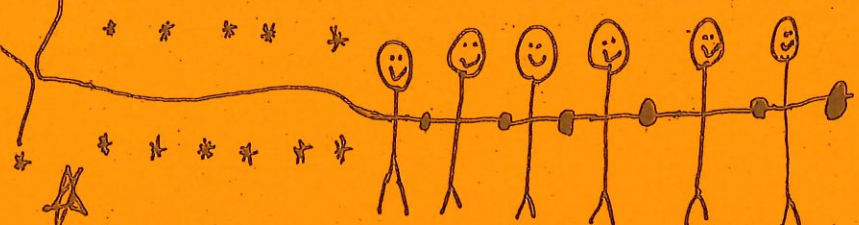
