Do please let the office know if you can help. **Parent Governor Election** A school governor term of office is four years, and parent governor Christophe Frèrebeau reaches the end of his term in July. We will therefore have a parent governor election at the start of July, with a full timeline shared after the holidays. Governing Bodies work with the school's senior leaders to determine the ethos, values and strategic direction of the school. They hold the school to account for the educational performance of the children, management of staff, oversee the financial decisions and ensure that the school complies ' with legal and statutory requirements. Our Governing Body also monitors pupil performance to ensure that all children have access to a broad and balanced curriculum, and involve and consult children and parents in this. We have a strong Governing Body and are not seeking a new governor with any particular skill set or experience. Our governors should reflect our community. All our parents are welcomed to stand for governorship, most important to us is that you are committed to helping EP deliver an ambitious curriculum that is fully inclusive, and to support us in always seeking to improve outcomes for all of our children. There are six early morning committee meetings and six early evening meetings a year, and support with childcare is available if needed. We also welcome governors to support us with recruitment and in monitoring, through meetings with children and staff.
