Christmas Trees through EP!

Order a tree through EP to be delivered to school and ready for pick up at the Fair. The trees are Nordmann fir, come from a sustainable source and we usually have great feedback about the quality of the trees. Far cheaper than local garden centres and all profits to EP. *To note that the trees do not come with stands.*

To order please make payment with Scopay online payments or through the school office. The price on Scopay will show as £0, so simply **overwrite the price** of the tree you want from the list below.

- 3-4ft (100/ 125cm) £25
- 5ft-6ft (150/ 175cm) £40
- 6ft-7ft (175/ 200cm) £50
- 7ft-8ft (200/ 250cm) £60

You can also order an undecorated wreath (12"/30cm) – again available to purchase on Scopay. Order deadline **Wednesday 23rd November.**
