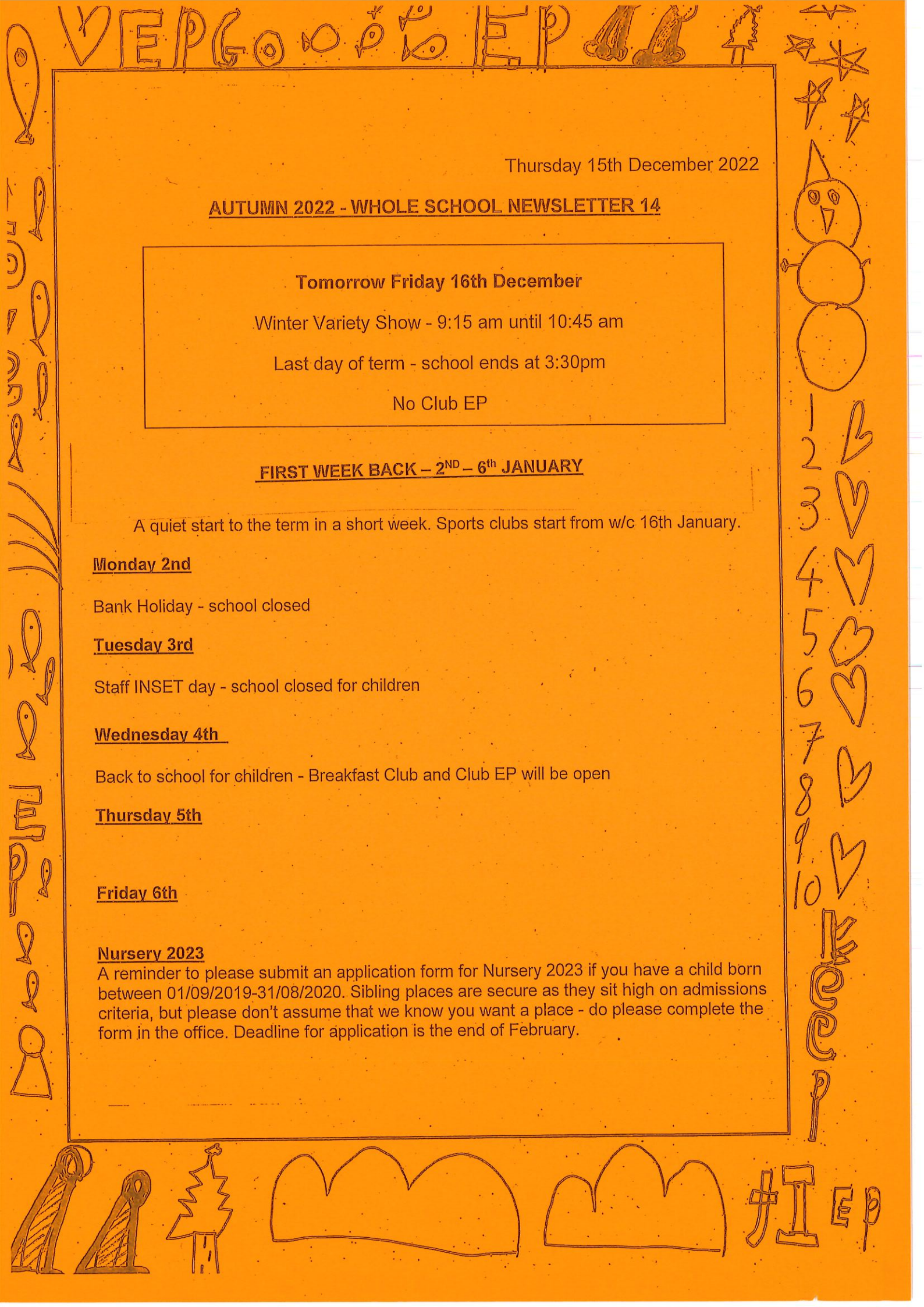
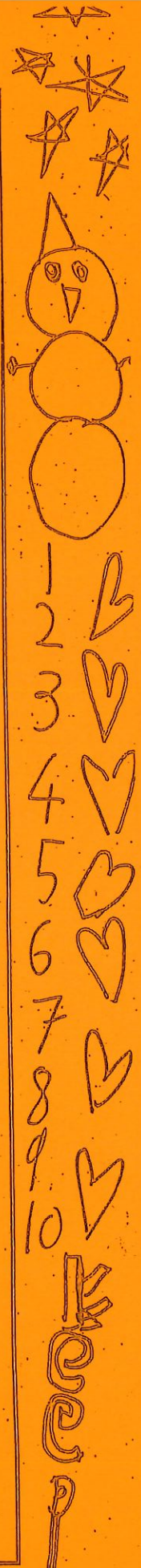
Back to school for children - Breakfast Club and Club EP will be open
