National Assessments

We end the year with fantastic results in the National assessments which take place at the end of Reception, Year 1 (phonics), Year 2, Year 4 (multiplication check) and Year 6. This is testament to your wonderful, hardworking, interested and interesting children! It's also testament to the great teaching teams across our school. We are in the top 3 schools in Camden for our Early Years results and our cohort of Year 1 children have made phenomenal progress in the development of early reading. We have high numbers of children working at greater depth across our school. In Year 6 100% of our children reached the expected standard or above in reading, against a national percentage of 73%. The number of children reaching the expected standards or above in reading, writing and maths at the end of Year 6 is 86%, against the national average of 59%. We are so proud of the progress and hard work shown by all the children.
