... the **Life Skills** we're learning about this month: self-belief, honesty, courage and resilience.


... what to spot in nature this January: deciduous trees, fallen leaves that shelter animals, and the first signs of spring including snowdrops, blossom and crocuses.

week! Every class has plunged into their **new topics** with enthusiasm and the school feels busy and happy. Please take the time to read the Curriculum Letters written by your children's teachers as they give such a lot of detail about what each class will be learning, along with advance notice of trips and visitors. We love having your support on trips, as well as parent visitors with skills to share, so please let class teachers know if you're available.

This term, in contrast to the autumn, is much shorter, with only four more weeks until the half term holiday. However, it is always a term in which children really progress, building on everything they have learnt so far and feeling confident in their year group. Teachers will be writing each child's **Progress Report this term**, ready for Parent Meetings on 25th and 26th March and we hope all of you will be able to recognise and celebrate with us how far your children have come over the last year.



Ensuring your children are ready for school each day on time, taking advantage of the soft start at 8:45am for extra learning, are simple but essential ways you can support them to go from strength to strength. You will notice that **attendance** is now very much on the national agenda and the life changing impact of absence from school is being highlighted. In school, given that there are bugs about, we are emphasising hand hygiene - something you

can reinforce at home to ensure your children stay as healthy as possible. Attendance at EP is very good for the vast majority, but we are always looking for ways to support families in making it even better, valuing every moment of education. Reminder to apply for Nursery 2024

We are welcoming applications to our Nursery for September 2024. The deadline for application is the end of February. Free meals extension and funding

The Mayor of London has confirmed that children in Reception to Year 6 will continue to receive a free school lunch until the middle of 2025, ensuring that children can have a free nutritious meal in school every day.

Even though your child is receiving free meals automatically, if you receive certain benefits it is still vitally important that you register with Camden for free school meals, as the Government provides additional funding to schools for all eligible children. More detail on eligibility is attached. Amongst other things, this funding helps support costs for your child for extracurricular activities and to subsidise trips - including 50% off your cost for residential trips. It will also ensure that you have access to other benefits such as food vouchers and free childcare and activities in the holidays through HAF schemes. https://youngcamdenfoundation.org.uk/haf
