## **Parent Questionnaire 2021**

## 1. Highlights

Once again, parents are overwhelmingly positive in their assessment of the school. They are confident that the school is led and managed effectively (100%), that teaching is good (99%) and their children are making enough progress (97%). They agree that their child is safe (99%) and that their child enjoys school (99%). Overall, 99% are happy with their child's experience.

The positivity of the responses is particularly remarkable in a very disrupted and changing year for parents, who have on one hand, engaged intensively in their children's home learning, but on the other, have not been on-site, with the usual opportunities for chats with teachers and sense of involvement in school events.

We added a new question this year on inclusivity, to reflect how important this is to PPC and the school, particularly on dimensions of race and racism, ability, disability and additional needs. 95% of parents agree that the school works to be inclusive of all children.

We also added a question on Club EP, since the School has taken over the running of it. 92% of parents who answered the question said that they were satisfied with the provision. Comments from those not satisfied asked for more structured activities.

When parents disagreed, we asked them to elaborate in text boxes. This was a useful exercise, and we have discussed all the feedback in PPC (Parents, Pupils, Community) Committee.

Key 'Even Better Ifs' then discussed at the July full Governing Body meeting:

- greater diversity in the staff, which is an important long-term goal for EP, reflecting a wider challenge in Camden and nationally;
- enriching and diversifying the arts;
- as previously, requests for more extra-curricular activities, which we will consider via Club EP;
- some comments on feeling disconnected, or feeling that there is limited feedback, which underlines the importance of having parents on-site, and reinstating events next year.
