Thursday 28th

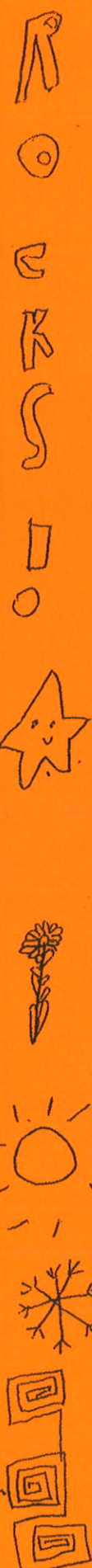
