Support Bluebelle's campaign! This Sunday 22nd

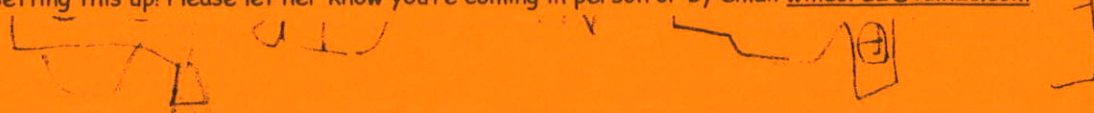
