Apply for Nursery 2016 - by February half term!

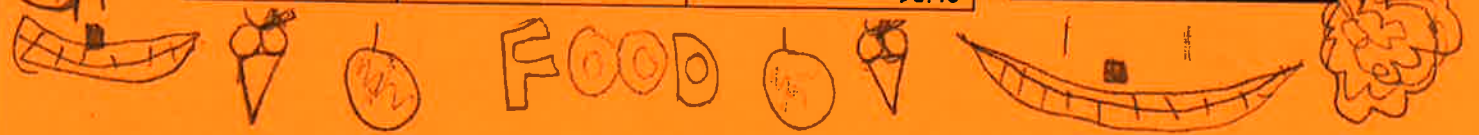

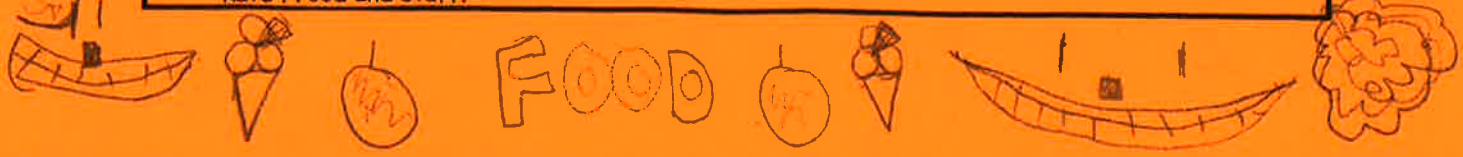
