Nasal flu vaccine - Friday 2nd November

The School Nursing Service are offering children in years Reception -Year 5 the flu nasal vaccine on 2nd November. All children in those year groups should have received a letter and consent form. Please return the completed consent forms **to the school office by Tuesday 30th October at the latest**. The office has spare forms and more information about the vaccine should you want to find out more. The vaccine takes only moments to administer and is absorbed very quickly in the nose. It cannot cause flu because the viruses it contains have been weakened. It does however help your child build up immunity so that when they come into contact with the flu virus they will be better able to fight off infection.
