Are you doing Amazon Smile yet?

We were alerted to this simple fund-raiser for our Keep It EP campaign last term. A few summer books bought by me has yielded just 46p so we do need LOTS of people to use it. It is SO simple. Here's how:

Amazon Smile

1. Google Amazon Smile. To set it up, you enter your email/phone depending on what device, and your Amazon password.
2. Choose Eleanor Palmer School Association as your chosen charity
3. You then have an Amazon Smile account.
4. Delete the ordinary Amazon app (you cannot access Amazon Smile through this)
5. From your Amazon Smile homepage in safari, press the  button at the bottom of your screen and choose 'add to home screen'. The Amazon Smile icon then appears as an app on your phone - and should say 'supporting Eleanor Palmer School Association' at the top - you then just use it as usual.
6. Every eligible purchase bought through this donates 0.5% to EP! Over time this will accumulate!
