Flu immunisation reminder - Reception to Year 6

Reminder that the school nursing immunisation team will be in for the flu nasal immunisation straight after half-term on Tuesday 29th. This simple nasal spray is quick and painless and helps protect your child, and other children, from the flu. Please return your form tomorrow or Monday 28th, even if you have decided not to give consent to the immunisation. Nursery children are immunised at your GP surgery.

Christmas Cards - IMPORTANT

Your child's Christmas card design is coming home today! The large artwork they bring home is then reduced and professionally printed (they then look amazing) onto a Christmas card or even gift labels, mugs or wrapping paper! There is a small profit for the school on every pack you purchase. Your child's name is proudly displayed on the back of each card and you can select the seasonal message you want inside, or simply leave blank. The price for a pack of 12 cards is £5.50, mugs, 2 x sheets of wrapping paper and tags are all £6.

This year all orders are placed online, so once you are ready to order:

- 1) Login to <https://www.cauliflowercards.co.uk/>
- 2) Click **Parents Shop** (top right on screen) and then **Parents Order Here** tab.
- 3) Enter the **School Code** and **Unique Code** found on the top left of the order form sent home.
- 4) Start shopping! Don't forget to add your child's name and select greeting on the orders page.
- 5) Check out and make payment.

****Orders must be placed by **Sunday 3 November**. The order portal closes after this date.

- 6) On your paper form **complete Box 2** for pupil name and class, and **tick box to indicate payment**.
- 7) Return completed form to the **school office by Wednesday 6th November**. The artwork will be collected by courier.
- 8) Orders will be delivered to school at the start of December!

A reminder that you can support EP when you shop online using the Easy Fundraising Scheme <https://www.easyfundraising.org.uk/causes/epps/> and selecting Eleanor Palmer. It doesn't cost you extra and there's no catch - the website takes you to hundreds of online shops and then credits the school for any purchases you make. Small amounts, which quickly add up. It's easy to sign up - you just need to remember to use it!
